Spiritual Direction is

- a relationship with the intention of supporting and nurturing another person's relationship with God
 - holding space
 - holding focus
 - enabling God to be the director
 - enabling God to be recognised, experienced, responded to



Communication

- all communication is mediated
 - inwardly what is shared, how it is spoken of
 - outwardly language, context
 - medium sound, written, transmitted (eg. phone, internet, hardware, software ...)
- when very familiar with a particular medium it is easy to forget how much we are assuming in this complex process



The Digital Medium

- Zoom (not the only option!)
 - all have limitations and peculiarities
- Experience has proved...
 - SD is possible!
 - God is in the process!
 - This is not a 'virtual' encounter it is real!

Adjustments

- to basic practice
- to inner disposition / expectations
- to actual practice

Being there:

- Face to Face:
 - listening responding exploring God you life Spirit's lead - concluding
- On Zoom:
 - listening responding exploring God you life Spirit's lead - concluding

Director - Directee Experence



- Face to Face:
 - Director: finished? get up coat door goodbye reflect / self-supervision - supervision...
 - Directee: finished get up coat door goodbye travel / reflect - follow up ...
- On Zoom: finished? yes click out!

Starting Well



- Preparation:
 - what can you do to prepare well?
 - practicalities resources to hand
 - prayer / centring / poise
- Arriving:
 - Marking the entering into 'sacred space'
 - Candle, silence ...



Starting Well



- Helping Directee Adjust to Medium
 - *Mechanics* connecting / fall back
 - Their Space light / sound / background / hide self-view
 - Your Space light / sound / background / hide self-view
 - Boundaries door / phone / computer alerts / doorbell ...
 - Our Space naming and entering its reality

Starting Well



- Helping Directee Adjust to Process
 - Preparation:
 - invite preparation
 - offer 'review' type exercises
 - for busy zoomers what helps make this difference to a work conference call?
 - Arriving:
 - Marking the entering into 'sacred space'
 - Candle, silence ...

Ending Well



- Directee:
 - time for post meeting reflection
- **Director:**
 - Awkwardness of clicking 'Leave'
 - 'I'll leave you to find your way out'





- Reflection:
 - what wisdom have you been discovering?
 - what might you incorporate to your practice?
 - what challenges do you need / want to rise to?
 - what questions remain?

The Filling!



- Spiritual Direction is Spiritual Direction
- but there are differences!



- head / shoulders / their environment
- picture quality

what you hear

- sounds amplified / lost / interference
- how you relate / interact:
 - face to face not oblique
 - looking into space





- the interchange can be
 - harder work more tiring
 - using a different balance of senses / internal processes
 - visual limited body language
 - aural words / tone
 - presence sense of their being
 - intuitive sub-conscious 'listening'



- the interchange can
 - have greater focus medium seems to sharpen interaction
 - have greater detachment poise can be easier
 - have more awkward silences
 - have difficulty engaging with strong emotions
 - be more stilted talking over each other



- the interchange
 - can need adjusting to over several sessions
 - can be surprisingly fruitful
 - is worth reflecting on and working at

- Implications for your Basic Practice
 - go to computer/tablet rather than front door
 - setting the environment making explicit what was implicit in the way you prepared the room for meeting people



- Implications for your Inner Disposition
 - welcome the opportunity for change - growth - learning...
 - accept changes so that your struggling with them doesn't get in the way of your attentiveness
 - hold your poise, your focus, your trust in the process and in your calling / gifting / faith
 - return to beginner's mind



- Implications for your Actual Practice
 - take opportunity to develop
 - when changing more preparation and reflection on experience is needed
 - be attentive to the niggles
 - to your energy and needs
 - keep centred on God and your role
